HOW TO APPLY

Admission Policy & Procedure

First Impressions Academy (FIA) admits students of any race, color, national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available to students of the school. FIA does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national, religious and ethnic origin, the administration of its educational policies, enrollment policies, scholarships, and other school-administered programs. FIA reserves the privilege of setting and maintaining our own standards of student conduct, dress, tuition, fees for services and scholarships. FIA reserves the right to refuse admission or to dismiss anyone who violates the school's standards set forth in the Parent/Student handbook or as defined by administration. FIA also reserves the right to change any policy as deemed necessary with or without notice.

FIA is committed to providing the best possible education for every child accepted in our program. The admissions process consists of collecting and receiving an application, previous school records, teacher recommendations, interviews, assessing the needs of the student, and willingness of the family to partner with the school's mission and vision. Please use the admissions process checklist to ensure that all necessary information is collected.

Entrance Requirements

There is a \$75 application fee due with the application and is non-refundable. Students K-8th grades seeking admission to FIA are required to attend school for a shadow day and take an entrance exam to determine proper grade placement. Administration may accept recent standardized test scores from another school or psychologist if available. It will generally be necessary for a student to score on or above the grade level being requested. Entrance testing is administered by the director. Students who are applying for our Kindergarten program should be turning 5 years old on or before August 31st. A teacher recommendation form is also required to be handed in with your packet and must be filled out by the most recent teacher from your previous school/daycare.

WHAT'S NEXT?

After the application is processed, and the fee is paid, the parents/guardians will be contacted by the Admissions office to schedule an interview with the prospective family and student(s) to finalize the process and administer the entrance exam. This interview is also an opportunity for us to hear your family's goals and to evaluate how we can best serve your student(s). The director will review the application, test scores, transcripts (if applicable) and interview information. Once accepted, the applicant must make an appointment to register in order to hold their prospective slot. The office will issue a welcome packet with any other information needed pertaining to enrollment.

A student will be officially enrolled and given a class assignment:

- ✓ After he/she is accepted
- ✓ After the annual curriculum fee of \$600(k-5th) or \$650(MS) has been paid
- ✓ After the first month's tuition has been paid (postdated check or card on file)

We look forward to meeting your family and are here to guide you in your choice for a private education.

ADMISSIONS PROCESS CHECKLIST

Listed below are the required steps for admission into First Impressions Academy. A student will not be officially enrolled until all necessary documents have been received. Interested families are to submit a completed application for consideration. The following steps are listed for your review:

- ✓ Call the school to schedule a tour of FIA or inquire online at www.fiaprepschools.com
- ✓ Complete and sign an application for each child applying- both parents must sign (if applicable)
- ✓ Return application with cash, check or money order for \$75 for the application fee or by online invoice.
- ✓ Return completed Teacher recommendation form from previous school via sealed envelope or by the teacher via email or snail mail. They will **not** be accepted from the parent.
- ✓ Once the initial application process has been accepted, the school will schedule your student's shadow day and/or entrance exam. (Keep in mind that this is **ONLY** if there is a potential slot).
- ✓ Previous report cards (if applicable) – (most recent) and/or recent standardized test: (3rd-8th graders)
- ✓ After your application is processed and shadow day and/or entrance exam has been administered and accepted, the admissions office will schedule your registration appointment.
- ✓ **Once accepted and enrolled**, All new kindergarteners and incoming 7th graders must have a Health Assessment form completed and returned before the 1st day of school.
- ✓ Initial fees- Once accepted by admin, your student will be officially enrolled and given a class assignment after the annual curriculum fee has been paid and a postdated check for the first month's tuition is handed in with registration papers.
- ✓ **After registration has been completed**, we will need the following documents for your student's file: Official copy of birth certificate & Updated immunization records- children 12 years or older must provide documentation showing DTAP immunization within the past four years.

***Please be sure to follow these guidelines to avoid delays in the application process. ***
