STEMSpire-

July 6th -July 10th

At STEMspire Camps, we offer hands-on engaging themes that inspire creativity, critical thinking, and problem-solving through LEGO-based STEM activities. Each theme is designed to challenge and excite campers as they build, experiment, and innovate in a fun, and collaborative environment.

Each camp theme is packed with hands-on LEGO builds, problem-solving challenges, and teamwork activities to keep campers engaged and excited about STEM.

Monday: Speed Builders (Build, test, and race high-speed LEGO Technic vehicles while exploring how design, weight, and motion impact performance.)
